VIS ALPIN ALPINE SALT NASAL SPRAY

Please read the Directions for Use completely and thoroughly. Please contact your doctor or pharmacist if you need more information or advice.

In which areas does VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray help?

VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray moistens and purifies the nasal mucous membrane thanks to a special salt complex and prevents dry nasal mucous membranes. In addition it helps to soften and loose crusts and dry nasal secretions and can be used as accompanying treatment of a stuffy nose (e.g. due to a cold or allergy).

Indications for VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray:

- for the moistening, prevention and purification of dry nasal mucous membrane
- to accompany the treatment of a stuffy nose

What does VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray contain?

VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray contains alpine salt from the Salzkammergut and Austrian alpine spring water.

How should you use VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray?

Always use VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray as instructed.

Children and toddlers from the age of 2 years

1 spray several times a day as needed

Children from the age of 12 years and adults

1 to 2 sprays several times a day as needed

When using another nasal spray to reduce swelling, VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray should be used with sufficiently long time intervals between applications. Using the VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray regularly contributes to the success of its application.

What do you have to note when taking VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray?

Do not take VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray if you have hypersensitive reactions to the ingredients it contains.

Please contact your doctor or pharmacist if your symptoms do not subside within a week or if they worsen.

We are not aware of any interactions with other products or side-effects when the VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray is used as intended. There are no findings to indicate that the VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray should not be taken during pregnancy or lactation.

How should you store VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray, and how long can it be used?

The use-by date is indicated on the external packaging of the VIS ALPIN alpine salt nasal spray. Stop using the medical product once the useby date has passed.

Keep the product out of the reach of children.

 Do not store over 25°C.
